1. Draft amendment is granted.
2. The present applicants are before this Court apprehending their arrest for the offence registered before the Adalaj Police Station, Gandhinagar bearing CR. No.11216001250131 of 2025 dated 19.02.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 137(2), 87, 64(2)(m), 65(1), 115(2) and 351(2)(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 4, 6 and 17 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence(POCSO) Act, 2012. The present applicant no.01 is the brother of the original accused whereas, the applicant no.02 is the father of the original accused against whom, the afore-stated FIR is registered for the afore-stated offences.
2. It transpires from the Annexures of the application more particularly from Annexure-E that the Police Inspector at the Adalaj Police Station had place on record the report inter-alia

contending that they want to record the statement under Section 179 and 183 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and had specifically endorsed to the fact that they don't want to arrest the present applicants. However, the learned Sessions Judge rejected the Anticipatory Bail Application bearing Criminal Misc. Application No.137 of 2026 vide order dated 10.02.2026. Hence, the applicants are before this Court.

3. Considering the fact that the applicants are not be arrested as stated by the Investigation Agency as per the report placed before the learned 2nd Addition Sessions Judge, Gandhinagar, the apprehension is ill-founded, however, it is made clear that the applicants if are required to be arrested, 07 days prior Notice may be given.

4. The applicants to remain present before the concerned Police Station for recording their statements as witnesses on 02.04.2026.

5. With the aforesaid observations, the present application stands disposed of.
