Present Petition is preferred by the Petitioners (Original Accused) under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, seeking quashing of FIR No. 11191031260144 of 2026 registered with Shahibaug Police Station, Ahmedabad City for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 351(3) and 54 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
2. Heard learned Advocate for the Petitioners and learned APP for the Respondent – State. Learned Advocate Mr. Neel Kanabar appears and states that he has received instructions to appear on behalf of Respondent No.2 – Original Complainant and he would be filing his appearance during the course of the day. Registry to accept the Vakalatnama.
3. Rule. Learned APP waives service of notice for and on behalf of the respondent – State and learned Advocate Mr. Neel Kanabar waives service of Rule on behalf of the Original Complainant.
4. Learned Advocate for the Petitioners has submitted that the matter

has been amicably settled between the parties and they are now not willing to proceed with the complaint any further. He further submits that there are no antecedents against the petitioners.

5. Learned Advocate appearing on behalf Original Complainant – Kamlesh Keshrimal Jain, has placed on record the Affidavit dated 16.03.2026. He submitted that matter has been amicably settled between the parties and there is no objection if present Petition is allowed.

6. Considering averments made in the Affidavit as also the submissions made by the learned Advocates for the respective parties, the present Application deserves to be allowed and is hereby allowed. The F.I.R. 11191031260144 of 2026 registered with Shahibaug Police Station, Ahmedabad City for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 351(3) and 54 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, is hereby quashed and set aside qua the present Petitioners. Rule is made absolute.
