1. Heard learned Senior Advocate Mr. Nirupam D. Nanavaty with learned advocate Mr. Premal Rachh appearing for the applicant and learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent No.1 – State and learned advocate Mr. Zubin Bharda with learned advocate Mr. Dhruvik Patel appearing for the respondent No.2.

2. Both learned Senior advocate Mr. Nirupam

Nanavaty as well as learned advocate Mr. Zubin Bharda have stated that There are, in fact, four petitions arising out of two cross-complaints. The present set of two petitions has been preferred by the accused persons in respect of an FIR registered by one Mitesh Chaturbhai Prajapati, whereas, in respect of the FIR registered by the present applicant, two petitions have been filed by Mitesh Chaturbhai Prajapati and the complainant, Jeetu Chandnani, being Special Criminal Application No. 1974 of 2025.

3. These two petitions relate to the FIR registered by Jeetu Chandnani, whereas Mitesh Chaturbhai Prajapati and Jeetu Chandnani have preferred two separate quashing petitions, being Special Criminal Application No. 1974 of 2025 and Special Criminal Application No. 1975 of 2025, in which one Subhash Swami is the complainant and is also the petitioner in Criminal Misc. Application No. 7322 of 2022. According to the learned counsels appearing for the parties, vide

order dated 07.04.2025 in CAV IA Judgment, the present respondents were granted relief in the nature of a direction that no coercive action be taken against them till the final disposal of the main matter.

4. Learned Senior Advocate Mr. Nirupam Nanavaty and learned Advocate Mr. Zubin Bharda have stated that all four petitions arise from the same dispute, and a note will be filed by either side before the Registry of this Court for tagging all four matters together. In the meantime, since both contesting parties intend to conduct all four matters together, and in order to ensure that the trial against the present applicants—who are presently without any relief at the stage of issuance of notice—may not be adversely affected, learned Senior Advocate Mr. Nirupam Nanavaty submitted that this Court may permit the present applicants to seek adjournment before the trial Court until all four matters are clubbed together. Once all four matters are heard together, the Court can pass

appropriate orders. This relief shall be subject to any further orders that may be passed in the event that any of the parties faces any difficulty and moves an appropriate application.

5. Learned Advocate Mr. Zubin Bharda also could not dispute the fact that all four petitions arise out of the same dispute. Therefore, in the interest of justice, it would be appropriate if all four matters are heard together, for which either the present applicants or the applicants in Special Criminal Application No. 1974 of 2025 and Special Criminal Application No. 1975 of 2025 shall move an application for clubbing.

6. Considering the above consensus arrived at between the parties, till further orders, the applicants are permitted to seek adjournment in the ongoing trial before the concerned Court, if required. In the event any such application for adjournment is made, the trial Court is directed to consider the same and grant adjournment in view of the above consensus. Both parties are at

liberty to move an application for vacating this interim relief in case of any difficulty. Stand over to **4.9.2025.**
