ORAL ORDER

1. Learned advocate Mr. K. G. Brahmbhatt for the applicant submitted that the FIR came to be lodged after a considerable delay of 11 months. It is submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that as per the allegations made in the FIR, suicide was committed by the daughter-in-law of the present applicant on 26.09.2024 and the FIR came to be lodged on 09.11.2025. It is further submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that immediately after accidental death was registered on the very day, i.e., 26.09.2024, the statement of the complainant came to be recorded by the Investigating Officer, wherein he stated that he does not have any information with regard to cruelty or harassment or does not have any doubt about anyone.

2. It is further submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that two petitions were filed before this Court seeking directions for lodgment of the FIR and ultimately the FIR came to be lodged. It is submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that the son of the present applicant, i.e., husband of the deceased was deaf and dumb and suffering from Aphasia and the deceased was also suffering from a disease-like Hysteria and was having little less sense. It is submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that there was a 5-year marriage span and even as per the allegations made in the FIR, no proximity of cause is stated immediately before the suicide. It is submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that as per the allegations made in the FIR, the deceased had come back to the house one and a half years prior and left the parental house 2 months before, i.e., 17.09.2024 and thereafter the suicide was committed on 26.09.2024. It is further submitted by the learned advocate Mr. Brahmbhatt that none of the ingredients stated in the impugned FIR are satisfied and in that background, the continuation of the process is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

3. Having considered the above submissions, Notice returnable on 20.07.2026.
