The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent No.2 Mamlatdar & Executive Magistrate be directed to fix a new date for taking appropriate steps for taking possession of the property in question. The learned AGP appearing for the respondent No.2 submits that the respondent No.2 had already fixed the date for taking the possession of the property in question on 07.01.2026, however, by the communication dated 06.01.2026, the petitioner itself had informed the respondent No.2 to fix new date for taking the possession since they were not able to arrange for police protection. The learned AGP, therefore, submits that if petitioner is able to arrange for police protection, new date can be fixed and the petitioner may inform the new date accordingly to the respondent No.2 and on the said date, they will be able to get the possession.

In view of the above submissions, the respondent No.2 shall initiate fresh steps for taking possession of the property in question. Let needful be done by the petitioner before the next date of hearing. The respondent No.2 is directed to take appropriate steps accordingly.
