1. Heard learned advocates appearing for the parties in both the matters.
2. An additional affidavit has been filed by the applicant wherein reference has been made about the list of documents which has been produced on 31.08.2023. The applicant thus, states that the list does not include the CDR of the dummy number alleged to be used by the applicant and the CDR of one of the witnesses - Hetal

Ramesh Barot. Thus, it is stated that if such documents has not been relied on in compliance of Section 226 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter referred to in short as 'Cr.P.C.'), then no reliance can be placed on it. It is further submitted that compliance under Section 226 of Cr.P.C. is only in N.D.P.S. Case No.7 of 2008 and not in the rest of the matters, which is N.D.P.S. Case Nos.8 of 2013 and 6 of 2018.

3. The above additional Affidavit be paginated and is ordered to be taken on record.
4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor and learned advocate Mr. Rohan Majmudar appearing for the complainant have sought time for verifying the record of the trial Court. The same is granted.
5. In the interregnum period, the learned trial Court Judge to permit the Public Prosecutor to seek time and the matter be adjourned accordingly, till the next date of hearing.
6. Let the present matter be tagged with Criminal Revision Application No.1005 of 2026.
7. In Criminal Revision Application No.652 of 2026, **NOTICE** returnable on **JUNE 23, 2026**. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State and learned

advocate Mr. Rohan Majmudar appearing for the complainant waive service of notice.

8. In Criminal Revision Application No.1005 of 2026, no notice is required to be issued as the same has been already issued vide the order of this Court dated 10.04.2026.
