1 We have heard Shri Vishwas Sudhanshu Bhamburkar as party in person, Shri Kshitij Amin, learned counsel for the respondent – Directorate General of Civil Aviation, Shri Bhadrish Raju, learned counsel for the Airports Authority of India and learned counsel Shri Kunan B. Naik.

2 In the last order dated 02.03.2020 time was granted to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation to take a final decision after the hearing is duly afforded to the concerned parties and the matter was fixed for 20.04.2020. Shri Amin, learned counsel for the Directorate General of Civil Aviation, informs that although dates were fixed in the first week of March, 2020 for personal hearing, however, on account of request made by the parties to hold the hearing at Surat, the matter was adjourned and in the meantime, lock down came to be imposed due to pandemic COVID-19.

3 Today, Mr. Amin, upon latest instructions states that now fresh notices have been issued on 19.06.2020 fixing hearing dates for 7th to 10th July, 2020 and this hearing is to take place through video-conference. He, therefore, prays that reasonable time may be allowed to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation to take a final decision in the matter and to place the same before the Court.

4 As prayed for four weeks time is allowed. Let this matter be listed on 27.07.2020. By the next date, the Directorate General of Civil Aviation will file status report placing on record the decision so taken in the meantime.

5 The interim order granted earlier to continue till the next date and to abide by the decision that may be taken by the respondent Nos.1 and 2.
