Pursuant to the directions issued by our order dated 20.12.2019, the matter has been placed today. The petitioner who appeared in person is present. Shri Bhadrish Raju, learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 2 – Airports Authority of India has filed compliance affidavit, wherein, its primarily stated that whatever exercise to be carried out by the Airport Authority has been carried out and papers and reports have been forwarded to the Director, General of Civil Aviation, (hereinafter referred to as “DGCA”) and now, the matter is engaging attention of DGCA and final decision is to be taken by the DGCA.

Further Shri Kshitij Amin, learned counsel for the respondent no. 1 – DGCA has also filed an affidavit stating that DGCA after considering all the material placed before it, has issued notices and after receiving replies from the builders has fixed dates for personal hearing on 3rd March, 2020 and 4th March, 2020 and after considering all the material, a final decision would be taken shortly. He has prayed for four weeks' further time to conclude the matter and inform the Court about the decision so taken. Time prayed is allowed. Let the matters

be now listed on **20.04.2020.**

The interim order granted earlier to continue till the next date and to abide by the decision that may be taken by respondents nos. 1 and 2.
