1. Having heard learned advocate for the applicants and learned Additional Public Prosecutor Mr.Chintan Dave for the respondent State and having considered the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and delay caused in preferring the restoration application of the main matter stands condoned, with the cost of Rs.2500/- to be paid in Gujarat State Legal Service Authority, within a seven days from today.

2. The application which is filed for restoration of the main matter stands allowed and the main matter is restored to its original file. Ordinarily this Court, while restoring the matter, also restores the *interim relief*, but here there is gape of 173 days and it is not made aware about what had happened during interregnum period. In view of above, interim relief is

not restored. However, liberty is reserved in favour of applicant to file appropriate application for interim relief, if any.

3. With the above observations, both the applications filed for condonation of delay in filing restoration application so also the restoration application are allowed and disposed of accordingly.
