1. The captioned petition is filed against the impugned order dated 3.4.2026 passed by learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Auxi.) and 6th Additional District Judge, Banaskantha at Deesa in Civil Misc.Application No.88 of 2026 whereby the application for disbursement filed by the petitioner came to be rejected.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner was solemnized on 25.4.2026. He submitted that in order to solemnize the marriage of his daughter, the petitioner took hand loan from his relative and therefore, he has to now repay the same and therefore, he requires money. He submitted that a sum of Rs.9,40,123/- is lying in FDR with

the State Bank of India. Therefore, he prays for encashment of the said FDR lying with the State Bank of India.

4. Having considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and having gone through the petition, I am, prima facie, satisfied that the need of the claimant – petitioner is genuine. Therefore, the captioned petition deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. Learned Tribunal is directed to disburse entire amount lying in the FDR with the State Bank of India.
