1. Learned Advocates Mr. Shlok Shah and Shyam Shah appearing for the original complainant shall file their appearance before the Registry.
2. Present application is preferred by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of FIR No.11191045200218 of 2020 dated 08.03.2020 registered with Sola High Court Police Station, Ahmedabad City for the offences punishable under the provisions of IPC.
3. Heard learned Advocate for the petitioners and learned APP for the Respondent – State.
4. Rule. Learned APP waives service of notice for and on behalf of the respondent – State.
5. Learned Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and they are now not willing to

proceed with the complaint any further.

6. The complainant is present before the Court who has identified by the learned Advocates appearing on his behalf. He has also filed an affidavit dated 29.04.2026 on record indicating that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and there is no objection if present application is allowed. The said affidavit is ordered to be taken on record.

7. Considering averments made in the Affidavit as also the submissions made by the learned Advocates for the respective parties, the present application deserves to be allowed and is hereby allowed. The FIR being CR No.111910452000218 of 2020 dated 08.03.2020 registered with Sola High Court Police Station, Ahmedabad City is hereby quashed and set aside qua the present petitioners. Rule is made absolute.
