ORAL ORDER

1. Present bail application is filed under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023, by the applicant praying for regular bail, who is shown as the accused in the FIR as well as in the charge-sheet, registered vide FIR No.11210065251005 of 2025, who came to be arrested by Utran Police Station, Surat, for the offenses alleged to have been committed under Section 103(1) of the BNS, 2023.

2. The investigation is completed and charge-sheet has been filed.

3. As per the prosecution case, the original complainant who was having a security contract in Utran

Power House, was informed by his security supervisor on 11.10.2025 that, a security officer viz. Parth Harishbhai Vyas was lying unconscious and covered with blood, near his quarter. Hence, the original complainant had called the Doctor, who had examined Parth and had declared him dead. The original complainant having inquired from security officer Arvindbhai as regards the incident, he was informed that, Arvindbhai had seen security guard Shailendra Bhanupratap Yadav and Parth Vyas both quarreling at around 8:15 p.m. and thereafter, he had seen Parth lying near his house i.e. Parth's house, covered with blood. Thus, the FIR in question came to be registered.

4. Heard Mr.Dipesh Soni learned advocate for the applicant and Mr.Soaham Joshi learned APP for the respondent - State.

5. On perusing the charge-sheet papers, it appears that, the applicant along with co-accused Shailendra Bhanupratap Yadav had entered into the room of

deceased Parth, and had assaulted him and had caused grievous injuries on his face, and had caused his death. On further perusing the charge-sheet papers, it appears that the applicant had an express and overt role along with the co-accused Shailendra Yadav in committing Parth's murder. The Investigating Officer has collected culpable evidence against the applicant and the co-accused. As per the P.M. report, the deceased had sustained 10 external injuries as well as internal injuries. The Investigating Officer has recorded the statements of witnesses, who have implicated the applicant and the co-accused in the crime.

6. In the event, it does not deem fit to this Court to exercise discretion in favour of the applicant.

7. Accordingly, the present application is hereby rejected.
