COMMON ORAL ORDER

Today, when the matters are called out neither the applicants nor their learned Advocates remained present.

Perusing the record it reveals that vide order dated 29.02.2024, the coordinate Bench was pleased to call for reports about execution of conviction warrants against the applicant. Pursuant to that the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Valsad, has submitted the reports, wherein, it has been stated that after dismissal of Criminal Appeal on 13.04.2023, conviction warrants came to be issued and forwarded to Police Inspector, Valsad City Police Station, on the same day but said conviction warrants remained unexecuted.

In view of above, the Superintendent of Police, Valsad, is directed to take necessary steps for execution of conviction warrants
