1. Heard learned advocate Mr. Sumit Sikarwar for Mr. P.B. Khandheria, learned advocate appearing for the applicants and learned APP Mr. Tirthraj Pandya appearing for the respondent – State.

2. Perused the entire material on record along with the impugned FIR. It *prima facie* appears that the impugned FIR was lodged against the present applicants at the instance of one Vikramsinh Nondhubha Jadeja. Upon bare perusal of the impugned FIR, it appears that no material was found during the raid to support the allegations made by the said Vikramsinh Nondhubha Jadeja.

3. It is also pertinent to note that, for the offence allegedly committed on 10.03.2021, the impugned FIR was lodged on 28.03.2026, i.e. after a delay of five years, for which, no explanation has been offered. It further appears that the entire FIR is based solely on the narration of one Vikramsinh Nondhubha Jadeja.

4. In view of the aforesaid, issue **NOTICE** to the respondents, making it returnable on **24.07.2026**.

5. Learned APP Mr. Tirthraj Pandya waives service of notice for and on behalf of the respondent no.1 – State of Gujarat.

6. In the meantime, the investigation may continue, however, no coercive steps shall be taken against the applicants-accused till the returnable date.

7. The applicants are directed to cooperate in the investigation.

8. Direct service is permitted.
