ORDER

1. Present application is preferred by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.11208003230207 of 2023 dated 28.02.2023 registered with Gandhigram-2 University Police Station, Rajkot City for the offences punishable under Sections 4(3), 5(c) and 5(d) of the Gujarat Land Grabbing (Prohibition) Act, 2020 and Sections 504, 506(2) and 114 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. Heard learned Advocate for the petitioners and learned APP for the Respondent – State. Learned Advocate Mr. Kirtikant N. Solanki appears and states that he has received instructions to appear on behalf of the Respondent No.2 (Original Complainant). Registry to accept the Vakalatnama of learned Advocate Mr. Kirtikant N. Solanki and place it on record.

3. Rule. Learned APP waives service of notice of Rule for and on behalf of the respondent – State. Learned advocate Mr. Kirtikant N. Solanki appearing for the Respondent No.2 (Original

Complainant) waives service of notice of Rule for the Respondent No.2 (Original Complainant).

4. Learned Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and they are now not willing to proceed with the complaint any further.

5. Learned Advocate Mr. Kirtikant N. Solanki appearing on behalf of Respondent No.2 (Original Complainant) has placed on record duly sworn in Affidavit dated 08.06.2026 wherein it is stated that the complainant is having no grievances against the present petitioners. The same is ordered to be taken on record. Learned Advocate has submitted that matter has been amicably settled between the parties with a view to keep peace and harmony in the society and there is no objection if present application is allowed.

6. Considering averments made in the Affidavit as also the submissions made by the learned Advocates for the respective parties, the present application deserves to be allowed and is hereby allowed. The FIR being CR No. 11208003230207 of 2023 dated 28.02.2023 registered with Gandhigram-2 University Police Station, Rajkot City and all other consequential proceedings arising there from are hereby quashed and set aside qua the present petitioners.
