ORAL ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Mr. A.D. Modi for the petitioner.
2. Learned advocate for the petitioner, at the outset, submitted that the employer has not established the extent of loss for damage caused to the employer. It is further submitted that in the criminal proceedings, the petitioner has been acquitted and therefore, there is no question of the employee being involved in any offence involving moral turpitude.
3. In support of submissions, learned advocate for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the decision in the case of *Union Bank of India Versus C.G. Ajay Babu* reported in *2018 (9) SCC 529*.
