ORAL ORDER

(PER : HONOURABLE MS. JUSTICE SANGEETA K. VISHEN)

1. Mr Nirad D. Buch, learned advocate for the petitioner submitted that the corpus is missing since 17.09.2025. According to the petitioner, the corpus – respondent no.5 is illegally confined by the respondent no.4. After the corpus was found missing, General Diary Entry was lodged with the concerned police station; however, till date, the corpus is not traced out. This Court, confronted Mr Nirad D. Buch, learned advocate to point out as to what steps were taken after the General Diary Entry was registered on 18.09.2025. Mr Nirad D. Buch, learned advocate as fairly conceded before this Court that no steps have been taken except the parents visiting the police station. This Court also required the learned advocate for the petitioner to state as to why no First Information Report has been lodged to which Mr Nirad D. Buch, learned advocate has no answer.

2. Pertinently, the corpus is 25 years of age and major. It *prima facie* appears that the corpus had left on her own.

3. Mr Nirad D. Buch, learned advocate requests for some time so as to file the additional affidavit.
4. List the matter on 16.06.2026.
