ORDER

It appears that learned advocate appearing for the appellants is avoiding the proceeding after getting the interim-relief.

Time and again he has filed the sick-note. On the previous occasion, the sick-note was filed by him, which has been seriously objected by learned advocate Mr. Shyam M. Shah, this Court on 27.03.2026 granted the last time and further, instructed the appellants to make the necessary arrangement for argument.

Then, on the next date, i.e. on 15.06.2026, the matter was simply adjourned and interim-relief was extended.

Today, again Mr. Ajay S. Jagirdar has filed the sick-note. Again, learned Senior Counsel Mr. Asim Pandya assisted by

learned advocate Mr. Shyam M. Shah seriously object to the grant of time to the appellants.

In view of above, I do not approve the conduct of the learned advocate for the appellants, who is filing the sick-note or leave-note to extend the interim-relief.

Again, while reiterating the order dated 27.03.2026, the last chance is granted with the clarification that no any leave-note, sick-note or adjournment note shall be entertained and the appellants would be at the responsibility to keep any learned advocate present on the next date for arguing the matter, failing which the necessary order shall be passed.
