ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Ms. Shreya Chauhan for the petitioner. By way of the present petition, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:

“A. YOUR LORDSHIPS may be pleased to admit and allow this petition;

B. YOUR LORDSHIPS may be pleased to issue a writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction by directing Respondents herein to conclude and decide the conciliation proceedings in the Reference Case of the Petitioner, being Online Application UDYAM-GJ-01-0036481/M/00002 (annexed No. at Annexure B) within a period of 30 days, and further be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 herein to comply with the provisions of the MSMED Act, 2006.

C. YOUR LORDSHIPS may be pleased to direct Respondent No. 3 to forthwith comply with Rule 9(C) of the Gujarat

MSME Council Rules, 2017 by uploading the complete proceedings and records of the petitioner's matter bearing Online Application No. UDYAM-GJ-01-0036481/M/00002 (annexed No. at Annexure B) on the designated web portal.

C. Be pleased to grant any other relief/s as may be deemed fit and proper, in the interest of justice.”

2. Learned advocate Ms. Shreya Chauhan submits that the petitioner's application seeking initiation of conciliation proceedings has been pending since the year 2023 and that, notice has been issued on 05.06.2023, pursuant to which hearing was held on 27.01.2025 & 11.06.2026 wherein, petitioner was present and not the respondent of the said proceedings. Therefore, it was adjourned.

3. Considering the fact that the petitioner's application has remained pending since 2023, respondent Nos. 2 and 3 are directed to consider the said application and pass an appropriate order thereon as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of this order. Parties to the proceedings are directed to co-operate.

4. With the aforesaid direction, and without entering into the merits of the matter, the present petition stands disposed of.
