1. Heard Mr. Vishal B. Mehta, learned advocate appearing for the applicant and learned APP Mr. Tirthraj Pandya appearing for the respondent No.1 – State. Perused the entire materials on record along with the impugned FIR as well as charge-sheet papers and original investigation papers.

2. It *prima facie* appears that no specific allegations are levelled against the applicant by the complainant in the impugned FIR. It also appears that there is nothing on record which suggests that on 24.07.2025, the deceased was beaten by the present applicant.
