1) Heard learned advocate Ms. Janki Jadeja for learned advocate Mr. Vandan K. Baxi for the applicant and learned advocate Ms. Jayani B. Shah for respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

2) Both the learned advocates for the respective parties jointly submit that the matter has been referred to the Mediation Center, High Court of Gujarat, Ahmedabad and an agreement of mutual consent terms was executed between the parties, as the parties agreed to reside together with their minor daughter. As per the terms, the applicant was to take a house on rent and respondent Nos. 2 and 3 were to go and reside with him from 18-05-2026.

3) Learned advocate Ms. Jayani B. Shah for respondent Nos. 2 and 3 submits that on 18-05-2026, the applicant, along with his family members and elders, went to take respondent Nos. 2 and 3, but some issue has cropped up, due to which the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 did not come to reside with the applicant, and since then, the

issue is pending. Moreover, learned advocate Ms. Shah submits that the minor daughter is in the 9th Standard and respondent No. 2 had taken the School Leaving Certificate, but thereafter, as the amicable settlement did not take place on 18-05-2026, minor daughter was re-admitted to the same school.

4) Learned advocate Ms. Jadeja for the applicant submits that the applicant has taken a house on rent in Vejalpur area and has submitted a rent agreement, which is taken on record.

5) In view of the above, both the learned advocates for the respective parties jointly submit that they require some time to take instructions as to whether the applicant can make arrangements to rent a house around Gandhinagar, which would be affordable for him in view of the fact that school term of the minor daughter has started.
