ORAL ORDER

1. By the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for quashing and setting aside of the impugned notice dated 04.05.2026 issued by the Mamlatdar & ALT, Vatva in Case No.Tenant/T.A.S.84(C)/15/2025.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present impugned suo-motu notice has been issued after a period of more than 41 years. He submits that in the present case, the mutation entry No.1415 was effected in favour of the petitioner on 14.08.1985. He submits that the impugned notice has now been issued on 04.05.2026. The learned counsel further submits that in similar cases of the brothers of the petitioner and the petitioner himself, similar notice under Section 84(C) of the Gujarat Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act, 1948 [“Act” for short] have been stayed by this Court. He submits that various orders passed by this Court are annexed along with the present writ petition.

3. *Prima facie*, it appears that the impugned notice has been issued after a period of 41 years.

4. **Issue Notice returnable on 10.07.2026.**

Ms. Devanshiba Rana, learned Assistant Government Pleader waives service of notice for the respondent Nos.1 and 2.

In addition, Direct Service is permitted for the respondent No.2.

4.1 In the meantime, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 7-c till the next date of hearing.

5. Affidavit-in-reply, if any, may be filed before the next date of hearing.
