ORAL ORDER

1. Heard learned advocate Mr. Pratik Barot appearing for the appellants and learned APP Mr. Bhargav Pandya appearing for the respondent no.1- State.
2. Perused the entire material placed on the record.
3. The present appellants are the original accused nos. 1 and 3. It appears that they were charged for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 325, 326, 279, 323, 504, 506(2) read with Section 114 of the Indian Penal Code as well as under Sections 177 and 184 of the M.V. Act and under Section 135 of the Gujarat Police Act. After appreciating the entire evidence by the trial court, the appellants have been convicted for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 325, 326, 323 read with Section 114 of the Indian Penal Code as well as under Section 135 of the Gujarat Police Act. Since the appellants are assailing their conviction, the present appeal is required to be admitted.

4. **Admit.** Learned APP Mr. Bhargav Pandya waives service of notice of admission for and on behalf of the respondent-State.
5. The registry shall call for the records and proceedings along with the entire set of the paper book from the concerned trial court.
6. The original complainant is personally present before the Court and has requested for the legal aid.
