ORAL ORDER

1. Notice returnable on **16.06.2026**. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent–State.

2. Having heard the learned advocate for the applicants and upon perusal of the memo of petition, it transpires that respondent No.2 – original complainant, namely, Sumitraben Mukeshbhai Khant, had lodged a complaint on 30.04.2026 against Sanjaybhai, Kailashben and Kamuben. Thereafter, on 08.05.2026, the impugned FIR/complaint came to be lodged against the present petitioners.

3. It further appears that petitioner No.2 – Keshavbhai had also submitted an application on 29.04.2026 before the Police Inspector, Modasa Rural Police Station, District Aravalli, against various persons, including respondent No.2 herein.

4. Thus, prima facie, it appears that there are ongoing disputes between the parties with regard to the land in question and that complaints have been lodged by both sides against each other. The material placed on record indicates that the dispute pertaining to the land has culminated into the filing of various FIRs/complaints by the rival parties.

5. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, no coercive steps shall be taken against the present applicants in connection with the impugned FIR till the next returnable date.

6. Direct service is permitted.
