1. Perused the withdrawal of appearance note dated 19.06.2025 addressed to the office filed by learned advocate Mr. Vishvesh A. Pujara appearing for the respective parties and the office note dated 21.06.2025 pertaining to the same.
2. It prima facie appears that the aforesaid withdrawal of appearance note is neither annexed with any communication to respective parties and RPAD slip nor annexed with any acknowledgement by

respective parties of receipt of communication pertaining to the retirement notice/online consignment tracking report. Moreover, there is nothing on record to show by way of communication/letter that the client(s) has/have intimated the learned advocate that clients do not want to continue the learned advocate and are relieving the concerned advocate from the matter. Hence, the withdrawal of appearance note is not in compliance with Rule 133 of the Gujarat High Court Rules, 1993. In considered view of this Court, merely because of appointment as Assistant Government Pleader, apropos retirement from the matter will not *ipso facto* exempt the present learned advocate who wants to retire from the matter from following the due procedure as contemplated under Rule 133 of the Rules, 1993.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the withdrawal of appearance note dated 19.06.2025 filed by learned advocate Mr. Vishvesh A. Pujara for respective parties and the office note dated 21.06.2025 are declined herewith and disposed of accordingly.
