ORAL ORDER

(PER : HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE A.Y. KOGJE)

1. Learned Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that as the issue is arising out of matrimonial discord qua which an incident had taken place, for which the petitioner had sought Police intervention. However, the Report has been submitted by the Police, which has placed on record by way of Additional Affidavit, which report indicates that no offence has taken place necessitating of any steps in connection with application made by the petitioner.

2. *Prima facie* opinion of the Court, directions in order dated 06-02-2026 was to take decision and dispose of the complaint made by the petitioner, which in the opinion of the Court, direction stands complied with by filing of the report.

3. However, as there is matrimonial discord at the root of it, the Court deems it fit to permit the petitioner to join his father-in-law; Manubhai Kalidas Rupala and his wife; Pratikshaben as party-respondents herein so as to bring permanent solution to the ongoing matrimonial issue.

4. Considering such request, the petitioner is permitted to join his father-in-law; Manubhai Kalidas Rupala and his wife; Pratikshaben as party-respondents.

5. Accordingly, amend the Cause-title. Upon the amendment, issue **notice** only to newly added party-respondents making it returnable on **08.09.2026**. Direct service is permitted.
