ORAL ORDER

Ms. Masumi V Nanavaty, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the Petitioner – Insurance Company vehemently submitted that the original claimants have earlier preferred a Claim Petition before the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Surat, seeking compensation on account of the deceased – Mr. Jignesh Shanubhai, which came to be settled and compromised before the National Lok Adalat held on 14.09.2019. She further submitted that the original claimants in gross abuse of the process of law have preferred another Claim Petition seeking compensation on account of death of the same person in the very same accident, before the learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal (Main), at Dahod. She contended that dual claim petitions cannot be maintained.

Having considered the submissions of the learned counsel for the Petitioner – Insurance Company, the ongoing trial before the learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Dahod for seeking compensation on account of death of deceased - Mr. Jignesh Shanubhai is stayed till the next date of hearing.

In the meantime, Registry is directed to issue **Rule** to the respondents, returnable on **20.07.2026**.
