ORDER IN FIRST APPEAL

ORDER IN CIVIL APPLICATION

Heard Ms.Rekha Patel, learned AGP appearing for the appellant-State of Gujarat.

Upon considering the submissions made by Ms.Rekha Patel, learned APP appearing for the appellant-State of Gujarat, execution and operation of the impugned judgment and award is stayed till the final disposal of the present appeal on condition that the applicant-appellant deposits the entire awarded amount with interest and costs with the learned Tribunal within two months from the date of receipt of this order and upon deposit of such amount, the learned Tribunal shall disburse 30% of the amount in

terms of the award and the remaining 70% of the deposited amount shall be invested in F.D.R. in the name of claimants which shall be renewed periodically till final disposal of the appeal with periodical interest to the claimants. However, it is clarified that 70% of the deposited amount shall not be encashed by the claimants till the final disposal of appeal.

With these directions, the present applications stand disposed of.
