1. Heard Mr. Vishal K. Anandjiwala, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Manan Mehta, learned APP for the respondent State.
2. By way of this petition, the petitioner has prayed for quashing and setting aside the **FIR being C.R.No.11196044250253 of 2025 registered at Ataladara Police Station, Vadodara City**, for the offence under Sections 85, 115(2), 351(3), 352, 296 and 318 of BNS and other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
3. Learned Counsel has submitted that, the petitioner has been falsely roped in the offence and has not committed any offence as alleged against him. On the contrary, the petitioner has approached the police authority vide e-mail communication dated 14.05.2025 and then notice was also issued to respondent No.2 on 05.06.2025. Marriage span is of 8 years. Allegations levelled against the petitioner are general in nature and there is no specific allegation made against the petitioner qua cruelty and harassment.

4. In view of the facts of the case as well as the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Achin Gupta Vs. State of Haryana & Anr. Reported in 2024 INSC 369**, petition deserves consideration. Hence, **Rule**, returnable on **26.08.2025**. Ld. APP waives Rule for the respondent State.

5. Meanwhile, ad-interim relief in terms of para 5 (iii) is granted. Respondent No.2 to be served through the concerned Police Station.
