ORAL ORDER in R/CRIMINAL APPEAL NO. 918 of 2014

1. Perused the withdrawal of appearance note dated 19.06.2026 addressed to the office filed by learned advocate Mr. Nikhil S. Vyas for the Appellant and the office note dated 22.06.2026 pertaining to the same.
