ORDER

1. By filing the present petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- (A) Your Lordships may be pleased to admit and allow the present Special Criminal Application.
- (B) Your Lordships may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or directions to the learned 3rd Addl. District Judge, Vapi (Valsad) to expedite the trial of Sessions Case No.258 of 2020 and conclude the same on a day to day basis within a stipulated time frame of three to six months or as this Hon'ble Court deems fit;
- (C) pass any such other and/or further orders that may

be thought just and proper, in the facts and circumstances of the present case in the interest of justice.

2. This Court vide order dated 30.06.2026 had asked the learned trial Court to submit its report as regards the current status of trial. Accordingly, the learned trial Court has submitted its report, which indicates that the charge has been framed against the petitioner on 08.09.2021 and thereafter, only one witness has been examined.
3. Having regard to the fact that the charge has been framed in the month of September, 2021, the learned trial Court is requested to expedite trial and make an endeavor to conclude the trial expeditiously.
4. With these observations, the present petition stands disposed of.
