**ORAL ORDER**

1. Learned advocate, Mr. Lakhani, appearing for the applicants submitted that the cheque, which was dishonored, was issued by accused No.4, namely Jigar S. Mehta, who is proprietor of Mehta Finance. It was submitted that, though, the applicants are partners of Ratnajali Infra LLP, they have no connection with accused No.4 and despite that, they are joined in the complaint, which is filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, as accused. It was submitted that the notice, which was issued under Section 138 of the NI Act, was duly replied by the present applicants, contending the very same thing. However, the impugned complaint came to be filed against the present applicants by joining them as accused Nos. 1 to 3.
