**ORAL ORDER
(PER : HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE
MRS. JUSTICE SUNITA AGARWAL)**

1. A common question for consideration arises in this set of writ petitions and hence, they are being tagged together to be heard and decided, accordingly.
2. In the written instructions supplied by Ms. Hetal Patel, the learned Assistant Government Pleader for the State respondents, it is submitted that in spite of several communications made by the competent authority to the office of the National Highways Authority of India, the differential amount of compensation determined under the original award has not been deposited so far.
3. On the request of Mr. Maulik G. Nanavati, the learned advocate appearing for NHAI, the matters are posted after a period of three weeks to file affidavit of the Project Director, NHAI, PIU - Ahmedabad to explain as to why the differential amount of unpaid compensation to the petitioners under the original awards has not been deposited for a period of around six years, after the judgment and order of this Court, restoring the original award.
