ORAL ORDER**

1. Heard learned advocate Ms.Krishna Shah appearing on behalf of the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader Ms.Pooja Choudhary appearing on behalf of the respondent – State and learned advocate Mr.Hemang Trivedi appearing on behalf of the respondent – Gram Panchayat.

2. Learned advocate Mr.Trivedi tenders a copy of the communication dated 11.08.2026 whereby the Gram Panchayat has withdrawn the notice in question. Learned advocate would draw the attention of this Court that the withdrawal is subject to the Gram Panchayat initiating fresh proceedings in accordance with law. Having regard to such a submission, learned advocate would submit that the petition has become infructuous.

3. Learned advocate Ms.Shah for the petitioner would not

have any objection to the petition being disposed of and whereas, learned advocate would request that the rights of the petitioner may be reserved to contest any fresh notice which may be issued by the Gram Panchayat.

4. Considering the submissions as above, the following directions would meet with the ends of justice:-

- (i) The communication dated 11.08.2026 is taken on record.
- (ii) The present petition is disposed of basis the above communication with a liberty to the Gram Panchayat to initiate proceedings afresh, if so desire, strictly in accordance with law.
- (iii) Needless to clarify that in case any fresh proceedings are initiated by the Gram Panchayat, it would always be open for the petitioner to contest the same as per the available legal provisions.
