1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that after loosing in various proceedings in respect of the subject land in question, by RTS Appeal No.358 of 2024, the respondent nos.3 to 17 herein have challenged the mutation entry no.2690 dated 28.12.2010 in favour of the petitioners. He submits that while effecting the mutation entry no.2690 dated 28.12.2010 in favour of the petitioners, the respondents herein had raised objections, which came to be adjudicated and thereafter, the said mutation entry came to be certified in favour of the petitioners by order dated 07.07.2011. He submits that after a period of more than 15 years, the respondent nos.3 to 17 are now challenging the said mutation entry. He submits that the present proceedings are nothing, but abuse of process of law.
3. Issue **Notice**, returnable on 21.09.2026. Learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent no.1 and 2. In addition, direct service is permitted for respondent nos.3 to 17.

4. In the meantime, ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 12(C) is granted till the next date of hearing.
