1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that after loosing in various proceedings in respect of the subject land in question, by RTS Appeal No.391 of 2024, the respondent nos.3 to 18 herein have challenged the mutation entry no.2299 dated 24.10.2008 in favour of the petitioners. He submits that while effecting the mutation entry no.2299 dated 24.10.2008 in favour of the petitioners, the respondents herein had raised objections, which came to be adjudicated and thereafter, the said mutation entry came to be certified in favour of the petitioners by order dated 29.06.2010. He submits that after a period of more than 14 years, the respondent nos.3 to 18 are now challenging the said mutation entry. He submits that the present proceedings are nothing, but abuse of process of law.
3. Issue **Notice**, returnable on 21.09.2026. Learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent no.1 and 2. In addition, direct service is permitted for respondent nos.3 to 18.

4. In the meantime, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 8(C) is granted till the next date of hearing.
