ORAL ORDER

1. Heard Mr. Mehul Sharad Shah, learned advocate for the petitioners.
2. Mr. Anuj K. Trivedi, learned advocate has instructions to appear on behalf of respondent Nos.1.1 and 4. He is permitted to file his vakalatnama.
3. Mr. Shah, learned advocate for the petitioners, under the instructions of his clients, would state that without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the petitioners, at this stage, petitioners are ready to deposit a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- with the Registry of this Court within 15 days from today and in the meantime, the *Jangam* warrant, which is issued by the executing Court, may be stayed. It is also submitted that the petitioners are also desirous to amicably settle the dispute with respondents, more particularly, respondent Nos.1 to 6.
4. Having heard the learned advocates and considering the fact that the petitioners are showing their bonafide to deposit some amount and

also they are desirous to settle the dispute with the judgment creditors, more particularly, respondent Nos.1 to 6 herein, till the next date of hearing, the *Jangam* warrant issued by the executing Court vide its impugned order dated 15.06.2026 is hereby stayed on a condition that the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- with the Registry of this Court on or before 15th July, 2026.

5. Stand over to 17th July, 2026. List on top of the board. Direct service is permitted.
