ORAL ORDER

1. Heard Mr. P. V. Buhrani, learned Advocate for the applicant.
2. At the outset, Mr. Buhrani, learned Advocate, would submit that after the passing of the order by this Court on 20.02.2025 in Misc. Civil Application (For Transfer) No. 498 of 2025, the applicant had preferred an application below Exh. 20 in Family Suit No. 142 of 2024 seeking travelling and other expenses, which came to be allowed by the Family Court on 15.11.2025, but despite such order, the applicant is not getting any travelling and other expenses as ordered. It is submitted that in absence of such amount, it is difficult for the applicant to travel from Vadodara to Ankleshwar and, as such, this Court has

reserved liberty in its aforesaid order to file an appropriate application before this Court seeking transfer of suit proceedings from the Family Court, Ankleshwar to the Family Court, Vadodara. Mr. Buhrani, learned Advocate, would submit that specific averments as regards the aforesaid facts are mentioned in paragraph No. 3.13 in the present application.

3. Having heard Mr. Buhrani, learned Advocate and considering the averments made in the application as well as the orders passed by this Court as well as the Family Court as referred above, *prima facie*, it appears that due to non-payment of the travelling expenses and other amounts which have been ordered by the Family Court vide order dated 15.11.2025, the applicant is not in a position to defend the aforesaid family suit. Accordingly, the matter requires consideration.
4. Issue Rule, returnable on 21.08.2026.
5. Ad-interim relief is granted in terms of paragraph No. 11(B) of the application.
