ORAL ORDER**

1. The present Admiralty Suit has been listed today at 2:30 p.m. upon urgent mentioning made by learned advocate Mr.Mamtora appearing on behalf of the plaintiff.

2. Learned Advocate Mr. Dhairya D. Mamtora for the Plaintiff has tendered purshish dated 29.06.2026 and submitted that the Plaintiff and Defendant have sorted out the issue outside this Court directly, and that the Plaintiff has received INR 68,46,545/- towards full and final settlement of its claim amount of INR 72,90317/- and that it has been agreed that either parties shall not have any claim against each other in respect of the present dispute and hence, the Plaintiff does not want to proceed further with the captioned suit and prayed for vacating arrest order dated 25.06.2026 forthwith and pass incidental directions.

3. In view of the purshish filed by the Plaintiff, the captioned suit is disposed of as withdrawn unconditionally without an effective hearing. The Order dated 25.06.2026 is vacated, and the Defendant Vessel is released with immediate effect and further permitted to sail and/or beach.

3.1. The Registry is directed to issue a Release Warrant forthwith.
