1. It is submitted by the learned counsel Shri Joshi appearing on behalf of the learned counsel Shri P.B. Patel appearing on behalf of the applicant-original complainant that two different cheques were issued in favour of the original complainant by the original accused, whereby two different criminal proceedings came to be initiated against the original accused. At the end of the trial in both the cases, the trial Court held the accused

guilty and rendered the judgment and order of conviction and sentence, which later on came to be assailed by the original accused by way of two different appeals, whereby the lower Appellate Court in one of the appeals confirmed the judgment and order of conviction and sentence, however, in another appeal, the lower Appellate Court reversed the judgment and order of conviction and sentence. Both these orders i.e. judgment and order of acquittal as well as judgment and order of conviction and sentence, are assailed before this Court by way of Criminal Revision Application No.80 of 2015 and Criminal Revision Application No.18 of 2015 by the original complainant and the original accused respectively.

2. Today Shri Mahendra Patel, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-original accused is not present.

In view of the same, let the matters appear on June 26, 2015. The interim relief, if any, shall continue till then.
