1. Issue Notice, returnable on 15.10.2026. Learned APP waives service of Notice on behalf of the Respondent – State.
2. Upon perusal of the FIR and the other material collected during the course of investigation, it appears that the Petitioner No.1 herein was married to the deceased and the marriage was suffering from rough weather and because of the same, the Petitioner No.1 had gone to her parental house, and, as and when the deceased would go to her parental house to take her back, she would not come to her matrimonial house and the other Petitioners used to torture the deceased. Except this, there are no allegations against the Petitioners.
3. Having regard to the aforesaid aspect, no coercive steps shall be taken against the Petitioners till the next date of hearing. Needless to say that the Petitioners shall cooperative with the investigation.
