ORAL ORDER

1. When the petition was taken up for hearing, a broad consensus has been arrived at between the parties that out of the total demand of Rs.2,26,58,771/-, an amount of Rs.1,28,96,079.57 ps. is an undisputed amount and the learned advocate for the petitioner, upon instructions, submits that the said amount of Rs.1,28,96,079.57 ps. shall be deposited before the respondent No.1 – The Regional Provident Fund Commissioner on or before 14.07.2026.

2. It is contended by learned advocates for the parties that for the remaining amount of Rs.97,62,691.43 ps., the dispute remains.

3. It is submitted by learned advocate for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 that on depositing the said amount of Rs.1,28,96,079.57 ps. on or before 14.07.2026, the recovery proceedings shall not be proceeded further.

4. In view of a broad consensus having arrived at without entering into the merits, the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs.1,28,96,079.57 ps. on or before 14.07.2026, on a condition that the respondent Nos.1 and 2 shall not proceed with the recovery proceedings.

5. It is made clear that on non-compliance of the deposit shall automatically vacate the protection.
