Learned AGP, upon instruction, states that so far as employees of the Labour Court in the State of Gujarat are concerned, the proposal is received by the Government from the High Court with recommendation and after receipt of the proposal, the file was processed and Finance Department has raised certain queries about Court-wise detailed calculation/break up. It is also stated that the High Court has forwarded the details with respect to the employees of Industrial Court while details of the employees of the Labour Court has not received by the Government. It is also stated that the queries raised by the Finance Department will be forwarded to the High Court shortly and necessary follow up action

will also be taken at the end of Legal Department for collecting the said details.

Accordingly, the learned advocate appearing for the High Court shall instruct the concerned officials of the Registry to take necessary steps to provide required information by the Government in this regard. It is expected that the High Court will respond to the queries raised by the Government at the earliest so that file can be further processed and necessary orders can be passed by the Government in this regard. If necessary the Secretary, Legal Department may convene meeting of the concerned official for expediting the process.
