1. The present matter has been listed in view of the note filed by the learned advocate for the applicants to revive the captioned contempt application, as liberty was reserved by this Court vide order dated

17.09.2025 to revive the matter by filing a simple note before the Registry of this Court in case, the actual benefits are not paid to the original writ petitioners.

2. Learned Assistant Government Pleader Ms.Pooja Ashar at the outset, has submitted that so far as the State Government is concerned, the Panchayats, Rural Housing and Rural Development Department has already passed an order approving the actual benefits, and communicated the same to the respective District Development Officers, to do the needful, so that the applicants can be paid actual benefits and reminders have also been sent.
3. In the order dated 17.09.2025, while disposing of the group of the captioned applications, this Court had observed thus:

“3.With this observations, we disposed of the present application. However, the liberty is reserved in favour of the applicants to revive the present applications by filing a simple note before the Registry of this Court in case, the actual benefits are not paid within a period of three months. We, further clarify that in case, the actual benefits are not paid within three months and the applicants are constrained to revive the applications, a personal cost of Rs. 25,000/- shall be imposed on the erring officers in each of the applications.”

4. Thus, in view of the liberty granted in favour of the applicants to revive the application, in case the actual benefits are not paid within a period of three months and since the same have not been paid at the ends of the District Development Officer(s) and the concerned officers of the Panchayats, we direct the revival of the captioned contempt application. The same shall be listed before the Bench assigned with such roster. It is further clarified that, as observed in paragraph no.3 of the order dated 17.09.2025, the cost of Rs. 25,000/- shall be imposed upon the erring officers of the District Panchayats in case it is found by the Bench assigned with the roster that they are responsible for the delay.
