ORAL ORDER

ORDER IN FIRST APPEAL:-

ISSUE NOTICE to the respondents returnable on **21.01.2026.**

Mr. Neel Vasant, learned advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. Tirth Nayak, learned advocate, waives service of notice for the respondent nos. 1 to 3.

Registry is directed to issue notice to other respondents.

Registry is directed to show the name of learned advocate, Mr. Tirth Nayak appearing on behalf of respondent no. 1 to 3 - original claimants.

ORDER IN CIVIL APPLICATION:-

Heard learned advocate for the applicant. Learned

advocate for the applicant submits that applicant is ready and willing to deposit 100% of the awarded amount.

In view of the statement of the learned advocate for the applicant, the execution, implementation and operation of the impugned award is stayed subject to deposit of 100% of the awarded amount before the learned Tribunal within a period of four weeks from today. Upon depositing of the said amount, the Tribunal is directed to release 30% of the awarded amount in favour of the original claimant, after due verification, through recognized RTGS / NEFT mode. The remaining 70% of the deposited award amount is directed to be invested in the Fixed Deposit with any Nationalized Bank initially for a period of 5 years which may be renewed from time to time till the final disposal of the appeal. The original FDRs are directed to be retained by Nazir Branch of the concerned Tribunal. It is further directed that no loan or advance against the aforesaid Fixed Deposits shall be allowed without prior permission of this Court, however, the original claimant shall be entitled to receive periodical interest which may accrue on such Fixed Deposit.

With these observations, the present Civil Application stands ***disposed*** of.
