Learned Advocates for the respective parties have submitted to the Court that the parties are in the process of settling the matter amicable and therefore, under instructions have stated that each party is ready and willing to withdraw their respective Police Complaints / FIRs that they have filed individually. Husband has filed FIR No.189/2022 under Section 323, 325, 341, 504 and 506 of IPC with Pathargama Police Station, District-Godda, Jharkhand and wife has filed FIR No.06/2021 under Section 498A, 406 of IPC and under Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act with Durgapur Police Station, West Bengal.

Thereafter, it is reported that the applicant is resident of Surat, whereas respondent-wife and the child are residing in West Bengal. However, both the parties are inclined to approach the Mediation Centre attached to this Court, where the wife has expressed willingness to appear by Video Conference.

In view of the aforesaid, the Registry is directed to refer the matter to the Mediation before the Mediation Centre attached to this Court. The Mediator to place on record the report of the Mediation on 12-06-2026.
