ORAL ORDER

1. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondents had preferred Mamlatdar Court Case No.6 of 2020 against the petitioners. That by order dated 17.12.2020, the said case came to be dismissed by the learned Mamlatdar. Thereafter, respondent No.6 preferred a complaint under the Gujarat Land Grabbing (Prohibition) Act, 2020, which also came to be dismissed by a communication dated 02.08.2024.

1.1. The learned counsel submits that by another communication dated 08.11.2024, the land of the petitioners was also measured, and it was confirmed that there was no land grabbing at the behest of the petitioners.

1.2. The learned counsel submits that thereafter, by communication dated 01.08.2025, a copy of which has been endorsed to the petitioners and the respondents as well, the Executive Magistrate and Mamlatdar, Talaja has written to the Superintendent of Police for removal of encroachment on the

complaint of the respondent No.6. He submits that the respondent No.6 to 8 have lost in all the proceedings initiated by them, but however by the present communication, the respondent authorities are taking the steps to remove the so-called temporary water channel, which is supposed to be on the land of the petitioners.

2. Issue Notice, returnable on 06.10.2025. The learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 5.

Direct service, in addition, is permitted **today** for respondent Nos. 2 to 8.

3. In the meantime, by way of ad-interim relief, the respondent Nos.2 and 3 are restrained from acting in terms of the impugned communication dated 01.08.2025.
