**ORAL ORDER
(PER : HONOURABLE MS. JUSTICE SANGEETA K. VISHEN)**

1. Mr. Hamesh C. Naidu, learned advocate for the applicant, submitted that the petitioner and the family members of the petitioner are ready and willing to extend full cooperation in searching out the corpus. It is submitted that the digital platform is already utilized but the other modes or the platform, if available, the petitioner is ready to participate and facilitate the same.

2. It is not in dispute that the corpus is missing since last more than one year, to be precise, since 24.06.2024. Despite close to two years, no fruitful result is achieved. This Court has passed orders after orders, either granting time or facilitating the investigation, but to no avail.

3. Today, Ms. Asmita Patel, learned Additional Public

Prosecutor, has submitted before this Court that the available modes are exhausted, after conducting the LVA and SDS tests. Hence, the Investigating Authorities, shall now switch over to the next level of the inquiry wherein, polygraph and brain mapping tests of the relatives of the respondent no.4 shall be conducted.

3. It is submitted that the Investigating Officer is mindful of the fact that the corpus is missing since last more than one year and hence, would be taking necessary steps to trace out the corpus. It is also submitted that for conducting the LVA and SDS tests, necessary application is to be filed with the Forensic Science Laboratory with a request to accord the priority which also, is likely to take some more time as, it is a time consuming process. Besides, consent of the person undergoing the test would also be necessary. If it is accorded, the test would be conducted or else steps shall have to be taken seeking necessary permission from the Court. It is urged that since the tests which now are being proposed, is time-consuming, some more time may be granted.

4. Acceding to the request and with the hope that by the next date of hearing, some positive aspect is reported, list the matter on 11.06.2026.
