ORDER

1. The issue involved in the present petition is pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court in Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.(s) 20144-20145/2016, wherein, the Hon'ble Apex Court has passed the order on 01.10.2018, which is reproduced hereunder :

"Leave granted.

In the meanwhile, no coercive action shall be taken against persons who are practising the Integrated System of Medicine pursuant to degrees/diplomas that have been obtained from Universities which are recognized for teaching the same."
