Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that, present appeals are filed mainly on the ground that on the date of accident, the driver of insured vehicle of Eco Sports car No.GJ 36 B 5399 was not holding valid and effective license and there is no provisions under the amended MV Act to pass order or to saddle with the liability to the insurance Company and therefore, the learned Tribunal has committed an error in awarding the compensation.
